National Pensioners Convention

We are affiliated to both the London Region and the national organisation. Our delegate is a member of the London Region Executive,

We sent sent 2 motions to the London Region AGM 2017:

To halt climate change we need drastic cuts in the amount of carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases put into the air. That means leaving most of the existing reserves of high carbon fuels in the ground. We need workers to insulate and retrofit homes and buildings to conserve energy. Workers to build enough renewable power to meet all our energy needs. And workers to maintain the new systems the future of humanity depends on.

As part of our commitment to intergenerational solidarity, we call on the National Pensioners' Convention to campaign, with Unions, the TUC and relevant pressure groups for Government to plan for immediate transition to a carbon zero economy, including:

- Energy democracy and a rapid transition from fossil fuels, including a ban on all Fracking.
- A stop to airport expansion
- Promotion of alternatives to short-haul flights, including publicly owned rail in UK and Europe
- A genuine commitment to reducing lethal air pollutants
- A just transition employment strategy to climate jobs and well-paid, skilled, sustainable employment
- Improved links between anti-war, refugee and climate campaign movements.
- Action against TTIP, CETA and other trade treaties threatening climate justice
- A Climate Justice Fund funded by wealthy nations and polluting companies.

If we want young people to help us defend our pensions we must help them to defend their future.

The second motion is the same as the one on the *Triple Lock* presented to the UCU Retired Members Annual Meeting 2016

Both were passed.

We sent two delegates to the Pensioners' Parliament

We shall be sending 2 motions to the forthcoming London Region AGM 2018:

Climate Change, Airport Expansion and Fracking

We recognise that the motion on Climate Change passed at this year's TUC makes progress towards the resolution on Climate Change passed at last year's London region NPC. However, we regret that there is no mention of opposition to fracking or airport expansion. We therefore call upon the NPC to continue to campaign within the trade union movement in support of all the demands raised previously.

ESOL and the older migrant

Given the rise of Islamaphobia and other forms of racism, this branch calls for the Government to immediately fund free ESOL classes in FE colleges and elsewhere within the public sector. While the facilities to learn to speak English should be the right of all migrants, we are especially concerned with the older non-English speaker who is likely to be especially isolated and disadvantaged.
